

SUPPORT FILES - GEOCODE & PATROL

Street File/Geocode File

- ◆ Larimore's Geocode system consists of:
 - Street File - a library of valid street names
 - Geocode File - contains all the address ranges, intersections and other geographical information
- ◆ Larimore can create the geocode using a variety of sources, including:
 - Department's existing shape files
 - County shape files (if applicable)
 - Converting a purchased mapping database
- ◆ With information from the department, Larimore creates overlays on the map that display the various reporting sectors/areas/districts
- ◆ The file handles multi-jurisdictional geocoded areas
- ◆ Larimore is experienced in creating specialty geocodes such as mass transit, railroad, & campus

Patrol/Hazard Files

- ◆ The Patrol files contain information based on person, vehicle, or location
- ◆ These can include Dangerous Persons, Medical Alerts, Vacant House, Restraining Orders, Sex Offenders Registration, etc.
- ◆ The Department can assign an expiration date to each patrol record to insure the information is timely and has been reviewed by appropriate personnel
- ◆ Patrol records will flag on a location, person or vehicle - this is extremely important so that a person or vehicle will flag independently of a location due to mobility
- ◆ Location hits may also be set with a range, ensuring that the officer will know there is something to take note of across the street from a particular call
